### TO PERSONS WHO HAVE APPLIED TO REGISTER AS PROFESSIONAL MINE SURVEYORS

Your application for registration refers.

As there is no degree in Mineral Resource Management available at present and until The National Qualifications framework is in place, the Council has agreed that as an interim measure Mine Surveyors may apply for registration as Professional Mine Surveyors if they comply with the following conditions :-

1. hold a National Higher diploma in mineral resource management - or equivalent and are in possession of a government certificate of competency and appointed under regulation 2:12:1.

OR

2. is a holder of a national higher diploma in mineral resource management and has a government mine certificate of competency and have not been appointed under the regulation, but in addition has a graduate diploma in engineering (GDE) obtained at the Witwatersrand University.

The applicant must, however, still write a law examination based on Act 40 of 1984 and the Rules as laid down by the S A Council for Professional and Technical Surveyors.

#### The application must be accompanied by :-

- (a) Completed application forms PMS 1A and PMS 2A
- (b) Certificate of employment. (See attached form 7(1)(c) PMS
- (c) Certified copy of Government Mine Surveyor's Certificate of Competency.
- (d) Certified copy of Graduate Diploma in Engineering (GDE)
- (e) Certified copy of National Higher Diploma.
- (f) A certified copy of your I.D. or birth certificate.

An application fee has been established to cover the cost of examinations, interviews and scrutinising. The fee will not be refundable in the case of a failed application and **must be included with your application**. For current fee pricing see 'Council Fees'.
